ASPIRE "LEADERSHIP" PROGRAMME

Andrew Walker (youth worker) from The Salvation Army, Manukau is running a Youth Development Programme with a selected group of Middle school students for the remainder of the year.

The Aspire programme commenced this week and will run for the next 30 weeks, every Thursday for 1 hour. The sessions are activity based learning, focusing on the Circle of Courage youth development model. It provides a fun, supportive environment for personal development, helping youth connect positively to others, achieve and master essential life skills, take responsibility for their decisions and live with purpose and generosity.

Part of the programme is a 3-day Adventure Experience at The Salvation Army Blue Mountain Adventure Centre in Tongariro. While there, our students will be offered professional outdoor activities which include tramping, abseiling, caving, white water rafting and more.

The programme also involves a community project where the students look at a need in their community and set up a project to help address that need e.g. painting a wall, cleaning up a park or feeding the homeless.

At the completion of the programme, there will be a graduation ceremony to celebrate the year and the achievements of the students involved.
