With the change in weather it is now time to make sure students come to school with their own water bottle. They need to hydrate regularly to stop the headaches they have been suffering from.

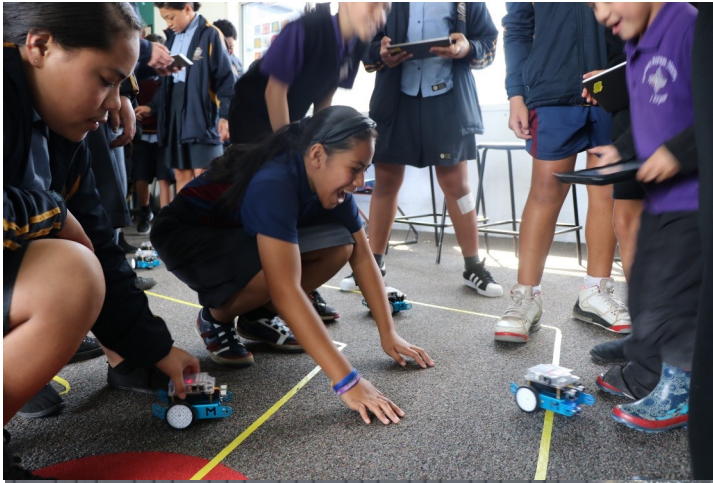


Piripono School came and joined in with our Maori Arts and Crafts Activity Day.
