



MESSAGE FROM MANAKIDZ CLINIC

From the Manakidz Health Team we would like to bring to your attention the rise in Measles cases particularly in South Auckland. Measles is caused by a virus that is passed through skin contact, or nasal secretions such as coughing or sneezing. If you think you have a fever and any of these signs:



Please contact your family doctor by phone or you can freephone **Healthline on 0800 611 116** and speak to a nurse and follow the advice given, there are also interpreters available.

Please lets ensure our tamariki/tamaiti/tamaiki are vaccinated on time against the measles with the MMR vaccine. If you are under 17 years old still eligible for the free MMR vaccine however there maybe a cost to see the doctor.
