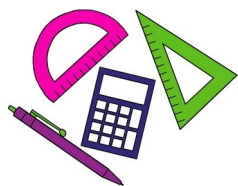
MATHS WEEK

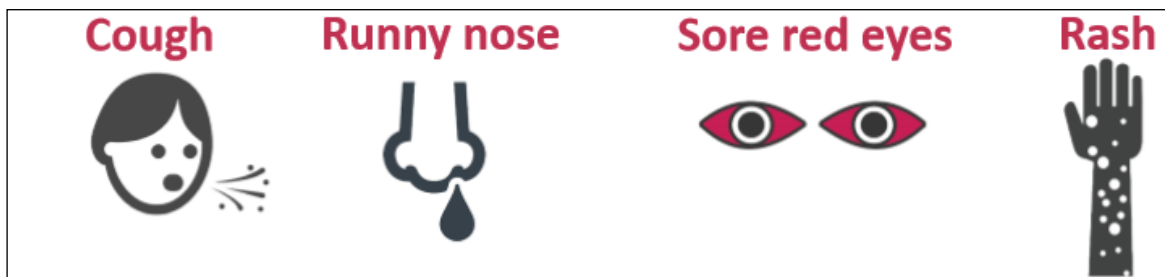

MESSAGE FROM MANAKIDZ CLINIC

From the Manakidz Health Team we would like to bring to your attention the rise in Measles cases particularly in South Auckland. Measles is caused by a virus that is passed through skin contact, or nasal secretions such as coughing or sneezing. If you think you have a fever and any of these signs:



Please contact your family doctor by phone or you can freephone **Healthline on 0800 611 116** and speak to a nurse and follow the advice given, there are also interpreters available.

Please let's ensure our tamariki/tamaiti/tamaiki are vaccinated on time against the measles with the MMR vaccine. If you are under 17 years old still eligible for the free MMR vaccine however there maybe a cost to see the doctor.
