Letter to our Parent Community

Dear Whanau,

We are now experiencing some very different times with Covid 19 variant, Omicron. We have had several confirmed positive cases in our school. I would like to assure you we are doing our very best to keep students separated from other students in other classes and schools. I know you may feel anxious about sending your child to school but I want to explain to you what we are doing:

- 1. Your child stays in their pod of 3 classes. They will learn and take breaks together. Students from other classes or from Junior or Senior School do not mix with them during the school day.
- 2. Each pod will have different breaks throughout the day.
- 3. Students and teachers are encouraged to keep their masks on unless they are eating.
- 4. Students sanitise in and out of the class.
- 5. Teachers monitor students wellbeing and health throughout the day .
- 6. Students not feeling well, parents will be contacted and we will either drop them off or the parent will arrange to pick them up.
- 7. While in class students work separated (I metre apart).
- 8. At the end of each day classroom surfaces are disinfected.
- 9. Classroom spaces are well ventilated.


If a student in your child's class tests positive for Covid 19 and they were infectious while at school we will notify you by phone and letter that your child will need to isolate. All instructions will be in the letter your child will bring home. If your child has other siblings in school they will not need to isolate. They will only need to isolate if a student from their class tests positive. You can however monitor other children in your family and if they show any symptoms they will need to go and get tested.

Covid 19 symptoms are:


- A new or worsening cough
- Sneezing and runny nose
- A fever
- Temporary loss of smell or altered sense of taste
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath


ICE BREAKER GAMES IN CLASS
