### Hiranga (Excellence) - Collegiate value



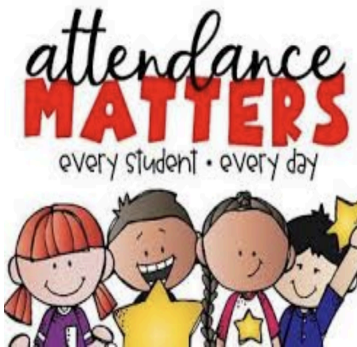
